**October 3, 2018**

**October 24, 2018**

*The Introduction to the Lord's Prayer:*

**November 7, 2018**

*The First Petition to the Lord's Prayer:*

## **November 14, 2018**

*What does this mean?* God's kingdom comes indeed without our praying for it, but we ask in this prayer that it may come also to us.

*When does this happen?* God's kingdom comes when our heavenly Father gives us His Holy Spirit, so that by His grace we believe His holy Word and live a godly life.

## **November 28, 2018**

*The Third Petition to the Lord's Prayer:*

Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

*What does this mean?* God's will is surely done without our prayer, but we ask in this prayer that it may be done also among us.

*When does this happen?* God's will is done when He hinders and defeats the power of evil and our sinful self, and when He strengthens our faith and keeps us firm in His Word. This is His gracious and good will.

## **December 5, 2018**

*The Fourth Petition to the Lord's Prayer:*

Give us this day our daily bread.

*What does this mean?* God gives daily bread, even without our prayer, to all people though sinful; but we ask in this prayer that He will help us to realize this and to receive our daily bread with thanks.

*What is meant by "daily bread"?* Daily bread includes everything needed for this life, such as food and clothing, home and property, work and income, a devoted family and good community.

## **December 12, 2018**

### *The Fifth Petition to the Lord's Prayer:*

Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.

*What does this mean?* We ask that our Father would not hold our sins against us, and because of them refuse to hear our prayer. And we pray that He would give us everything by grace, even though we do not deserve it. God asks us to heartily forgive others and do good to those who wrong us.
